

THESIS DELIVERY AND FINAL ASSESSMENT

When: Usually, around the end of September
Guidelines for PhD candidates

All the PhD candidates are called upon to submit the thesis and participate in the final assessment.

THESIS DELIVERY

On the occasion of the final assessment, candidates are required to send a pdf copy of their thesis to the committee, usually around the middle of September. The pdf copy is supposed to be the closest as possible to the final one. The final version of the thesis, to be submitted around a month before the defence, will also encompass the comments and observation received by the Final Assessment Commission and the External Reviewers.

FINAL ASSESSMENT

The Final Assessment is structured as a presentation to a commission composed by 3/4 professors, Supervisor is invited to join the assessment.

Each commission will examine 2/3 candidates, assessing their admission to the final exam.

Each candidate will present her/his work within a 30 minutes presentation. The presentation must clearly retrace the PhD research (subject of the research, theoretical framework, research questions, methodology, objectives, findings, results achieved, originality, future implications).

The presentation should be intended as the general rehearsal of the thesis defence, which will take place on February.
