Abstract	Nowadays the complexity of the cultural system and the advent of digital technologies implies a depth reflection on the role of design in terms of training, competencies and relationship between educational institutions and labour market in the field of the supply chain of culture. The new models of producing and experiencing cultural products entail a rethinking of the concept of cultural consumption and cultural experience, as well as the institutional strategies, and consequently a new approach to professional profiles. This research proposal aims at envisioning a 'landscape' of new professions and competencies on Design for Cultural Heritage in order to pinpoint and define new possible roles of the design discipline in answering the current request by institutions and creative and cultural industries.
